SCHOLARSHIP AND BURSARY GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS

Scholarships available at CRCS:

Scholarship and Bursary Stipulations:

1. If there is more than one successful applicant for either the scholarship or bursary, the amount will be divided in order to distribute all of the funds.
2. One student cannot win both a scholarship and a bursary, but can apply to both.

Scholarship recipients are selected by the school board. The Education Committee will make a recommendation to the school board following a review of all applications and discussion with the school staff for scholarship awards. Scholarships are presented at the June awards ceremony to Grade 12 students based on their application having met the established criteria. *The amount awarded is sent directly to the post-secondary institution of the student once proof of enrollment has been provided.*

The Education Committee considers the following to determine the eligibility of your application:

- Your transcript
- Your financial situation
- Your educational & career goals
- Your choice of college or university
- Two letters of reference/spiritual walk (*one from a pastor, one from a teacher*)
- Type written personal testimony/spiritual walk

Personal Testimony/Spiritual Walk: In approximately 500 words, please explain the following:

- Your testimony (how you became a Christian)
- How you are living out your faith
- Your answer to the question, “Why do you follow Jesus?”

The Application form is on the last page of the package.

Please **attach your type-written response** to the application form.

CRCS Scholarship Applicants

A scholarship will be offered to students with priorities as follows: Christian School Teacher, Full-time Christian Ministry or further post-secondary Christian School Education.

The qualifying application will meet the following criterion:

1. The student must be a growing Christian actively involved in their local fellowship and have a cumulative average of 80% for all completed Grade 11-12 courses.
2. An application form including a reference from the applicant's church leader and one teacher must be submitted no later than **April 4th, 2025**.

Please *attach* your **type-written response** to the application form.

CRCS Bursary Applicants

A bursary will be offered to students with priority in Christian Service (Pastor, Missionary, etc.)

The qualifying applicant will meet the following criterion:

- The student must be active in their local fellowship.
- Be active in service or leadership at school or local youth group.
- Have a cumulative average of 80% for all completed Grade 11-12 courses.
- An application form including a reference from the applicant's church leader and one teacher must be submitted no later than **April 4th, 2025**.

Please *attach* your **type-written response** to the application form.

Sandy Glum Memorial Scholarship

Sandy Glum was a CRCS teacher for more than 20 years, who was devoted to her students and the school. Students were drawn to her irrepressible personality and were inspired by her stories. Students formed lasting relationships with her. Sandy's courage and strength were remarkable during her battle with cancer and she openly shared this journey with her school and faith community. This scholarship is awarded to a student who embraces life.

The qualifying application will meet the following criterion:

- A student who has been accepted to a post-secondary institution.
- A student who is a committed follower of Jesus Christ.
- Have a cumulative average of 80% for all completed Grade 11-12 courses.
An application form including a reference from the applicant's church leader and one teacher reference must be submitted at the same time by **April 4th, 2025**.

Instructions to Redeem Scholarship Funds

CRCS will send funds directly to the post-secondary institution where the student is enrolled. **Scholarship recipients must provide the following information to the school bookkeeper (financial@crs.bc.ca):**

Proof of enrollment for full-time studies with a post-secondary institution (e.g. letter, email acceptance) including:

- Full mailing address for the school must be provided, including the department/contact name of the area of study if applicable.
- Proof of tuition payment to the school.

Requests for scholarships proceeds will be processed within a two-week period, provided the bookkeeper receives all of the required information from the student.
